Common rules that apply to all Events

1. All participants should be active members of SFTS. Team coordinators are requested to check the membership status and make sure the participants are Active members of SFTS. In the event of any participant not being active at the time of registration, they are requested to become SFTS members or renew their membership on or before 04/07/2018. Failure to do so may result in disqualifying the participant from the participating event
2. First come first served. Any SFTS member who fulfill the category rules and registers first will be given the slot to ensure unbiased selection
3. Program agenda will be made available to the registrants on the day of the event (4/14/2018) at the Venue.
4. SFTS Board has all rights to modify the order of programs as needed
5. **A person can only participate in one Group event (Dance or Singing) and one Solo event(Fancy Dress).** Fashion show and Thani tamizh are open to all. Anyone and everyone can participate in Fashion show and Thani Tamizh provided they are active SFTS members
6. Usage of harmful items, sharp items, are not allowed at any time
7. Unparliamentary language, hurting or abusive language are not allowed at any time
8. Participants and Registrants are responsible to provide their Music/Dance and to get their costumes. SFTS Board will not assist or provide any of these
9. Judges' decision is final wherever applicable
10. SFTS Board has all rights to disqualify any team/ participant if they don't follow any rule
11. SFTS Board has all rights to Add or Cancel any of the events with a valid reason
12. Rules are subject to change by SFTS Board

14. Program sequence will be decided by the SFTS cultural committee and will be revealed only on the event day before the program starts.
15. All items will be reviewed by the SFTS cultural committee and subject to their approval. Any inappropriate content will be requested to be removed prior to approval
